## HIGHWAY SHOULDER WIDTHS TE-2001-1

**WHEREAS**, the highway system is vitally important for the economic development of northeastern Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of the public using the highway system is in large part dependent on the design of the highway system; and

WHEREAS, the paved shoulders are an integral part of the design of a highway; and

WHEREAS, truck traffic is vitally important for the movement of agricultural and other commodities; and

**WHEREAS**, highways with substantial truck traffic need adequate shoulders for a margin of safety; and

**WHEREAS**, CDOT has in some instances recently reduced the paved shoulder width on certain sections of highways.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Progressive 15 strongly encourages that CDOT make a commitment to adding paved shoulders where none exist as well as maintaining the quality of those shoulders that are in place.
